




## Internship Programme

Since 2019, the University of Applied Sciences Bonn-Rhein-Sieg (H-BRS) has implemented an ERASMUS+ internship programme called "Get Balkanized", which is funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).

Within this internship programme we are able to grant annually 15-20 internships in institutions in Albania, Bosnia-Hercegovina, Kosovo and Serbia, so far up to 2022. In order to offer high quality internship posts we would like to extend our network of practise partners (political foundations, research institutions, think tanks, INGOs, social enterprises, public administration etc.) related to social, educational, labour market, health, or migration policies amongst others.




- Grant: 700 Euro per month + travel allowance (additional funding by the institution offering the internship is not mandatory) up to a maximum of 5 months
- Time windows for running the internships: February-September
- Applicants: students from the studying programmes Sustainable Social Policy (B.A.) and Analysis and Design of Social Protection Systems (M.A.)
- Announcement of internship positions: September
- Application period: October-December
- Preparation of interns: January-February
